 - 1. Your signed Social Security Card; AND
 - 2. One of the three documents listed below. The original document must be presented in person:
 - a. Alien Registration Receipt Card with picture. (I-151, I-551, or I-551C with valid expiration date)
 - b. Arrival Departure Record (1-94) with the INS stamp. (Proof of being processed for an I-551 with valid expiration date) The following statuses are allowed:
 - Refugee
 - Asylum Granted
 - Paroled (must confirm minimum of 1-year and status has not expired)
 - Conditional Entrant (valid only if issued before April 1, 1980)
 - Cuban/Haitian Entrant, status pending
 - c. T-visa issued to student or T-1 visa issued to student's parent

The following designations are not eligible for financial aid:

- an F1, F2 or M1 student visa
- an Employment Authorization Card (I-688A)
- a J1 or J2 exchange visitor visa
- a G series visa (pertaining to international organizations)
