## **Requirements:**

**Fall 2014—Enroll in UBE110\* - 2-credit course** – This course explores the foundational skills you need to be a student leader on or off campus. While examining the role of diversity, this course will use the Social Change Model of Leadership as a framework for understanding oneself and how to effectively make change in a community. This course is scheduled for Wednesday's from 2-3:40pm.

**Spring 2015—Enroll in UBE 496\*—1-credit course** – This course builds on the foundation of the fall course by focusing on advocacy and action on campus or in the local community. The course will meet every other week as an opportunity to reflect on your involvement in the community and to ensure you are making progress towards your cohort's goal to make a positive change in our community. This course is scheduled for Wednesday's from 4-4:50pm.
